

eligible for Medicare to get accurate information about coverage options they must make as they approach age 65. Seniors' Health Insurance Information Program (SHIIP) Counselors, trained by the NC Department of Insurance, will lead the information session to answer your questions. ADVANCE DIRECTIVES:

LIVING WILLS & HEALTH CARE POWER OF **ATTORNEY**

A **living will** is a legal document that allows you to make prior decisions about whether your life should be prolonged by certain medical procedures. A health care power of attorney is a legal document in which you give someone power to make medical decisions for you if you are not competent or if you are unable to communicate.


